

Australian Masters Games International Participant Policy

As at January 2019

POLICY INFORMATION

1. The aim of this policy is to outline the guidelines associated with participation by an international competitor in the Australian Masters Games (AMG).

POLICY KEY PRINCIPLES

2. This policy applies to all AMG participants and supporters who seek registration with the Games.
3. AMG accepts international participants and supporters from all countries.
4. AMG will provide participants and supporters with proof of registration, when all registration and associated fees have been paid.
5. AMG organisers will not supply visas or citizen sponsorship to any participant or supporter.
6. All immigration associated documentation to legally enter Australia is the responsibility of the participant.
7. AMG will under no circumstance agree to any financial undertaking regarding a participant's or supporter's visa or immigration situation.
8. AMG will not provide accommodation, local transport or health services to participants or supporters.
9. AMG recommends all international participants and supporters commence the procedure associated with obtaining their visa to visit Australia at least 6-8 weeks before their intended date of travel.
10. The Australian Government is the sole authority to provide visas to enter Australia through the Department of Home Affairs, Immigration and citizenship.

ACCOMMODATION AND ACCREDITATION

11. All athletes (both Australian and International) are responsible for the research, booking and payment of all accommodation needs related to the AMG.

13. Once participants arrive at the AMG, they are provided with an official Games accreditation pass, for identification purposes during the Games.
